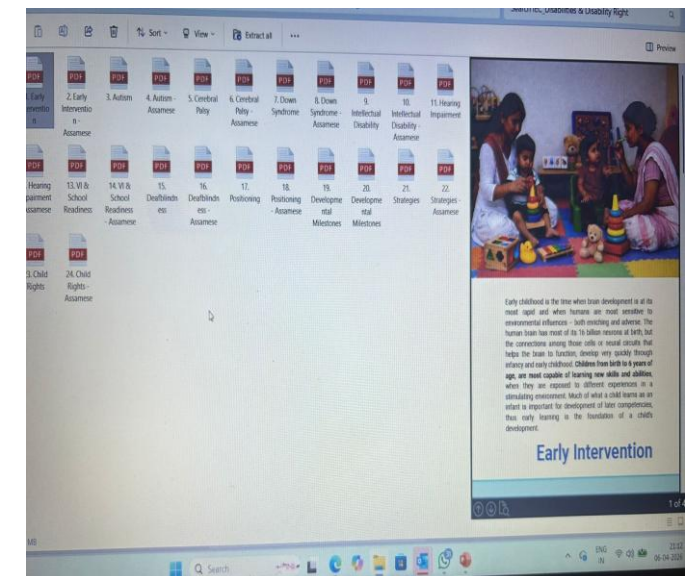
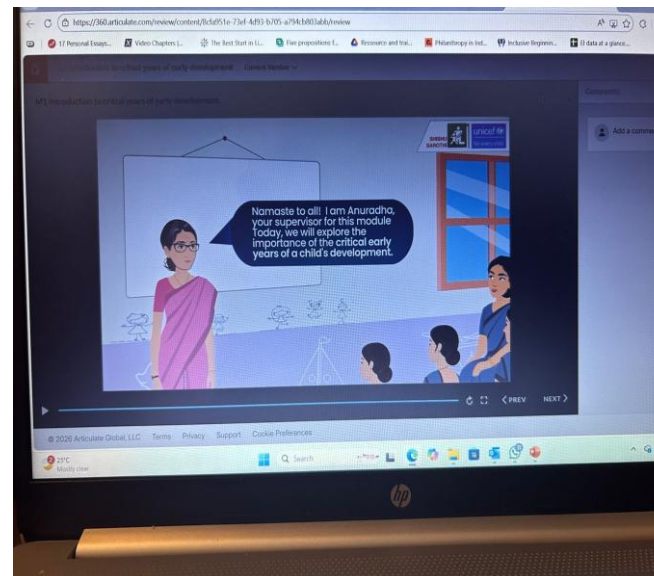
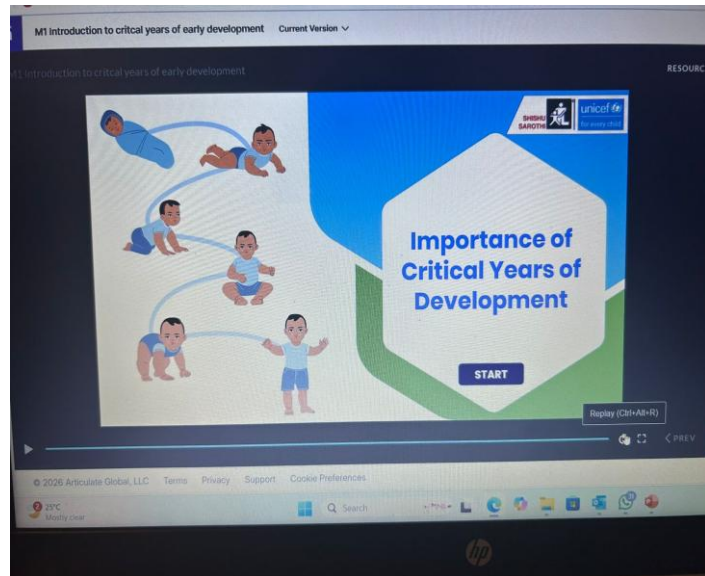
Education – SPARSH & Deafblind Resource Centre - SENSE India

Education – Inclusive Education Project -WIPRO FOUNDATION

- ▷ **10 govt schools & 733+ students** reached; **35 school visits** made ; **40 sessions** held at Learning Centres
- ▷ No major activities in April – schoolteachers preoccupied with book and uniform distributions in schools; Planned for new academic session with focus on strong learning outcomes, student engagement, community participation
- ▷ **25 students** taken for exposure in Guwahati in a collaborative **Park for All** campaign with ESAF Foundation with inclusive games and a Magic Show




Education – Inclusive Education Project WIPRO FOUNDATION

- ▷ **44 new students enrolled** 32 in Karbi Anglong & 12 in Kamrup (M)
- ▷ **4 students selected** to **2** centrally funded **residential schools**, from among 250+ applicants for 9 available seats! Great inspiration for first-generation learners in Karbi Anglong community
- ▷ Sanjana Das, **student with Hearing Impairment**, gets admission to multiple prestigious Guwahati schools
- ▷ **2 students** previously ranked 5th in class, **secured 1st position** in annual exams.
- ▷ **1** academically weak **girl student**, who was failing, **impressed her teachers** with significant **improvement**, and positive feedback to her parents.

She completed her early education at a government school, showing strong determination despite physical and social challenges.

Her elder sister has been her constant companion, who accompanied her to school every day during childhood when independent mobility was difficult.

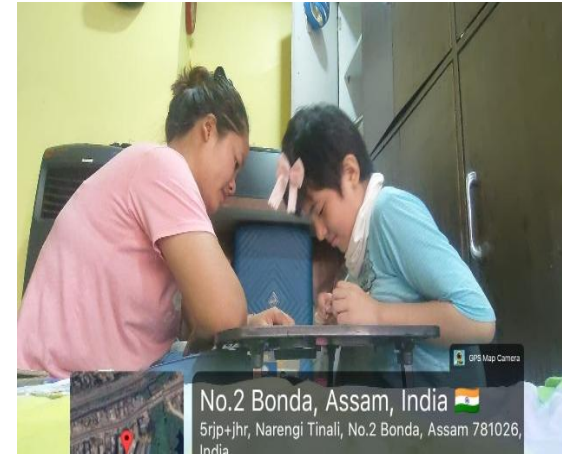

- ▷ **6 & 7 April:** Coordinated resource support by 2 senior colleagues for 11 staff members from **Ashajyoti, Sipajhar** through a **Capacity Building Program** on **formulating Individualized Education Plans (IEPs)** and **Individualized Rehabilitation Plans (IRPs)**.

Initiatives in the pipeline

- ▷ Proposal submitted to the Directorate of Census Operations, Assam for Sensitization and Training of Trainers on Disability for Census Population Enumerators.

Building Infrastructure

- ▷ 6 months into the APF-funded project for finishing the interior works - on track with fund utilization aligned to schedule.
- ▷ However, building handover from civil contractors Jyotsons Construction & Subrata Das still pending.
