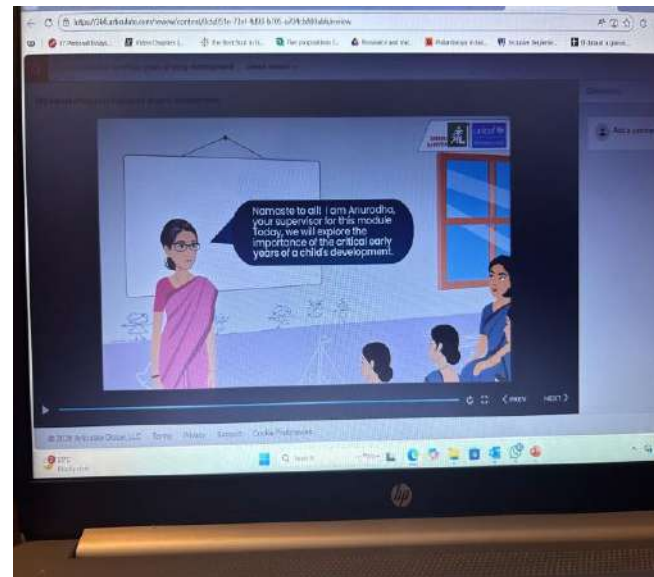

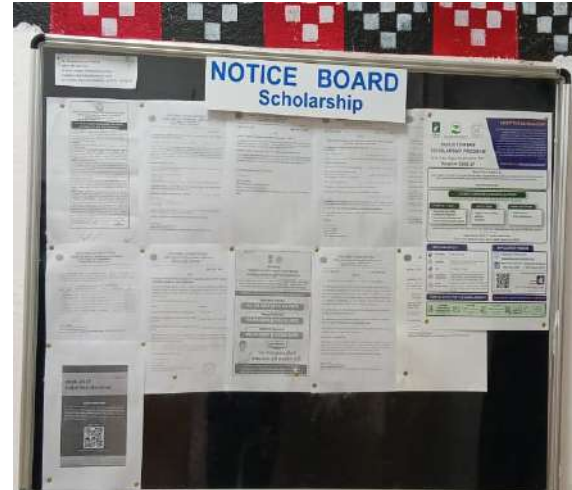
- ▶ **47** Learning Centres classes conducted in both districts. SSA schools closed for summer vacation.

Resource Support / Collaboration with other NGOs:

Discussion and planning for a **3-day capacity-building training** for 4 staff from **Action for Inclusion and Empowerment Trust (AIET), Kokrajhar**, as requested by them — covering disability inclusion, rights-based approaches, rehabilitation practices, and rehabilitation service management.

The training is scheduled for **19–21 August 2026** at Shishu Sarothi.

In-house Capacity Building:

Prepared a framework of In-house Indian Sign Language Training to commence from 10th August for the SS in – house staff.

The framework also includes a progressive learning plan covering everyday vocabulary, common phrases, and hands-on practice to ensure effective learning and application in the workplace.

Certificate Course:

The 3rd batch of the **Classroom Solutions for Inclusive Education** commenced with **22** participants - including 6 days in-person classes + 4 online classes in the month of July, 2026.

Publication:
