1 Classroom interior and exterior walls painted; routine maintenance of vehicles, plumbing, electrical works, generator, solar battery and garden supervised.

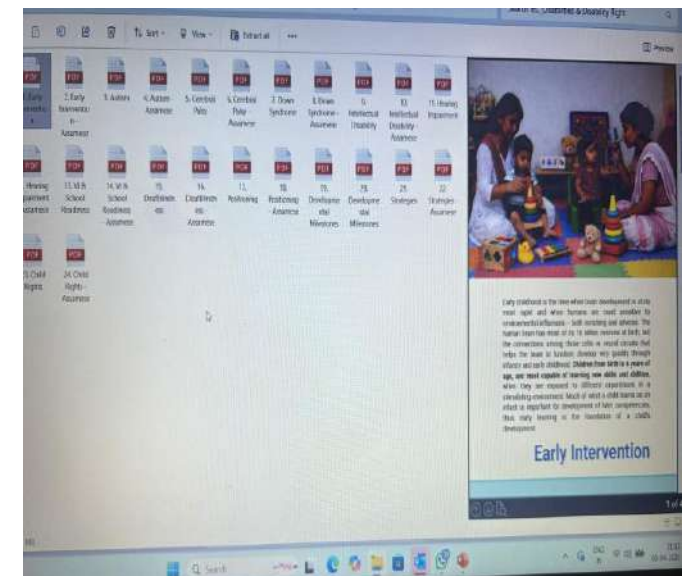
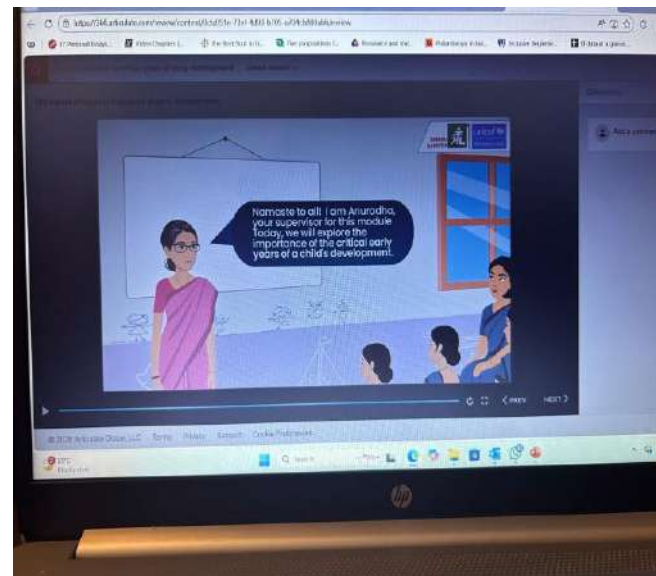
Education – SPARSH & Deafblind Resource Centre - SENSE India

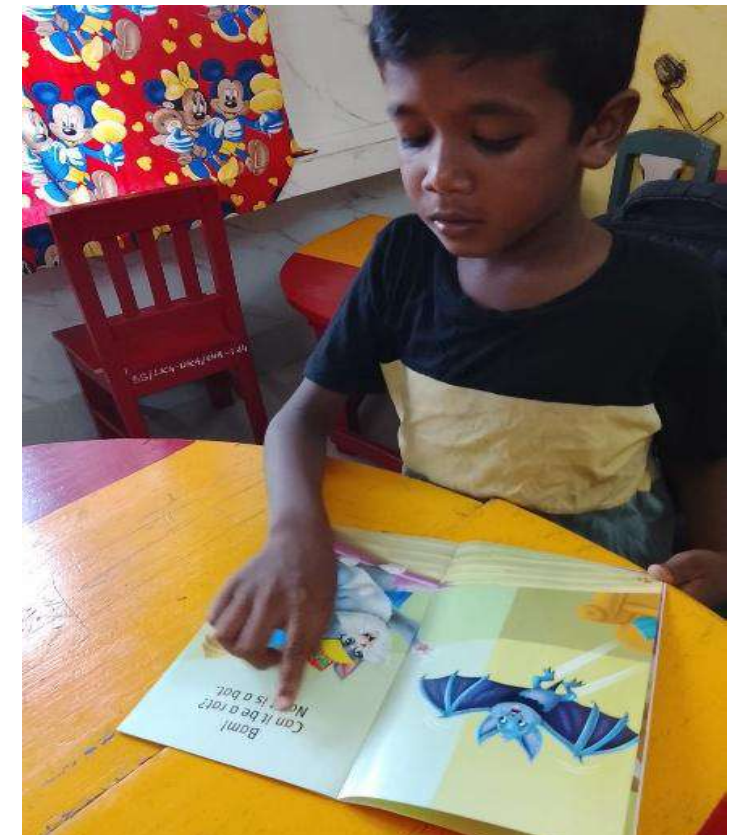

नई दिल्ली, 23 जून (एअॅसी)। दुनिया की सबसे बड़ी दूरसंचार अवसरचना कंपनियों में से एक इंडसटॉवर्स लिमिटेड ने, बहु-दिव्यांगता के पुनर्वास और प्रशिक्षण हेतु कार्यरत पंजीकृत गैर-लाभकारी संगठन शिशु सारोथी सेंटर फॉर रिहैबिलिटेशन एंड ट्रेनिंग फॉर्मलिटिएल डिस्पैबिलिटी के सहयोग से, पूरे भारत के दिव्यांग विद्यार्थियों के लिए इंडस टावर्स छात्रवृत्ति कार्यक्रम (आईटीएमवी) 2026-27 हेतु आवेदन आमंत्रित करने की घोषणा की है। अब अगले 10वें वर्ष में प्रवेश कर चुका इंडस टावर्स छात्रवृत्ति कार्यक्रम, कंपनी के प्रमुख सीएसआर कार्यक्रम 'सक्षम' के अंतर्गत एक महत्वपूर्ण पहल है। 'सक्षम' समावेशन और सशक्तिकरण पर केंद्रित एक एकीकृत पहल है। इस कार्यक्रम को शिशु सारोथी के सहयोग से संचालित किया जाता है। वर्ष 2016 से अब तक, इस कार्यक्रम ने 900 से अधिक योग्य दिव्यांग विद्यार्थियों को महत्वपूर्ण वित्तीय सहायता प्रदान की है, जिससे वे अपनी शैक्षिक आकांक्षाओं को पूरा कर सके हैं। यह दीर्घकालिक साझेदारी समावेशी शिक्षा के लिए एक सशक्त उत्प्रेरक के रूप में उभरी है, और अनेक छात्रवृत्ति प्राप्तकर्ता आज सरकारी तथा कॉर्पोरेट क्षेत्रों में सफलतापूर्वक कार्यरत हैं।

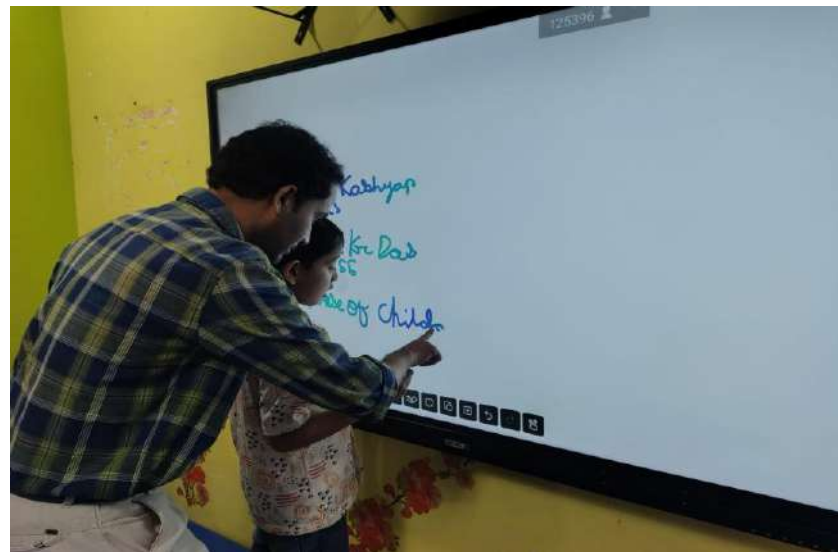
