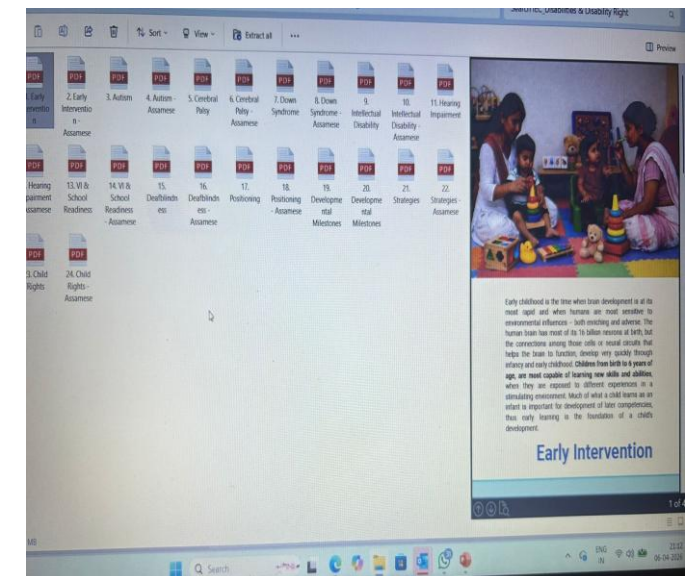
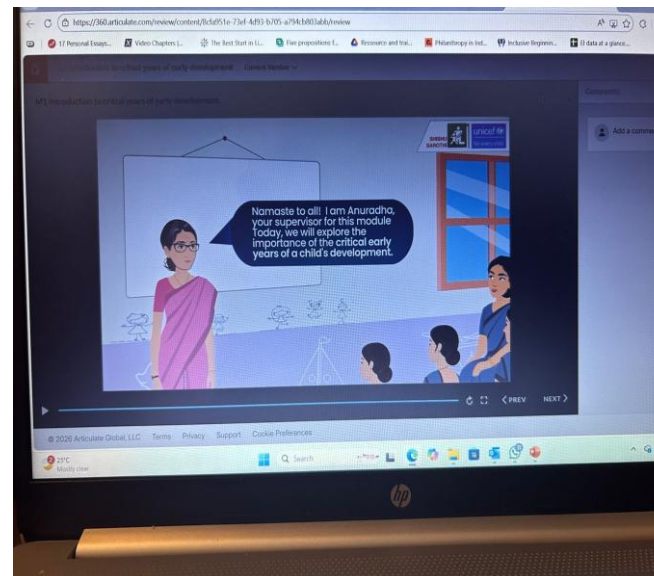
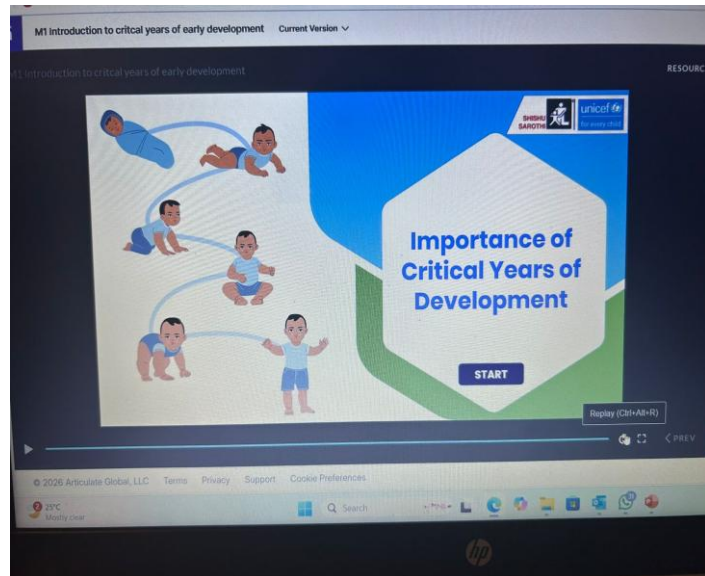

Scholarships

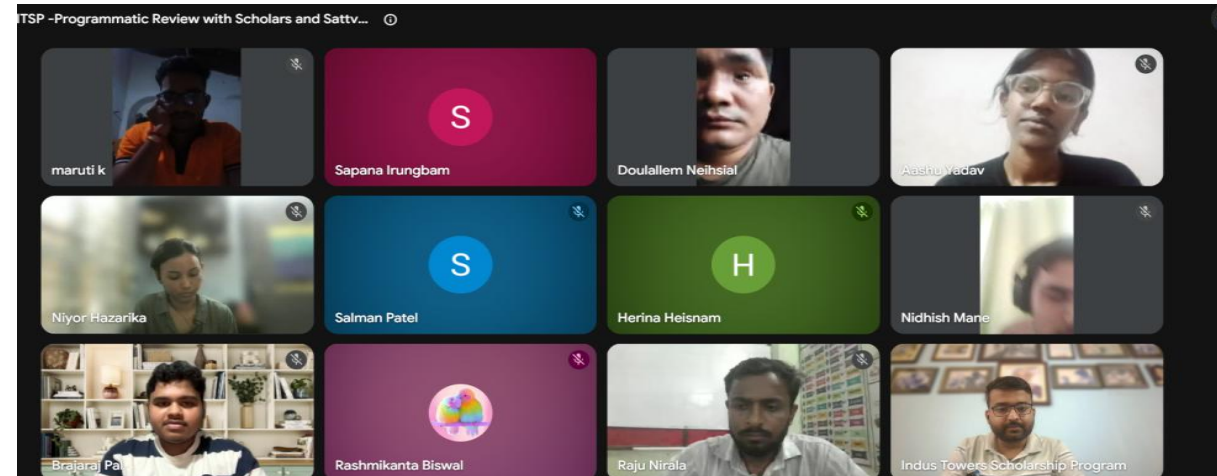
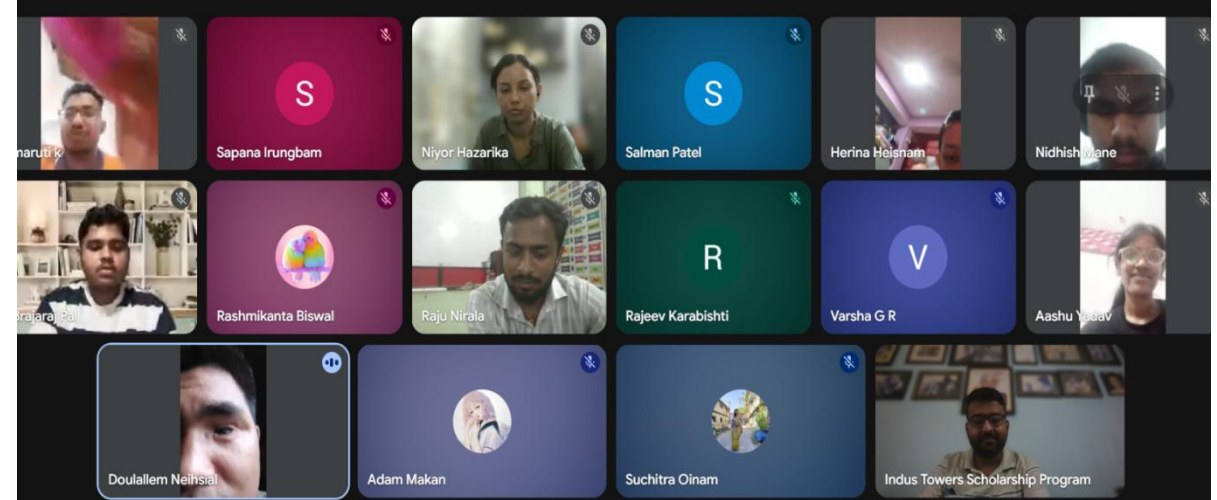
2 scholars' success stories shared with SATTVA Consultants, highlighting personal journeys, education progress & impact of scholarship on their lives

Scholarship disbursement deferred to June due to late receipt of funds.

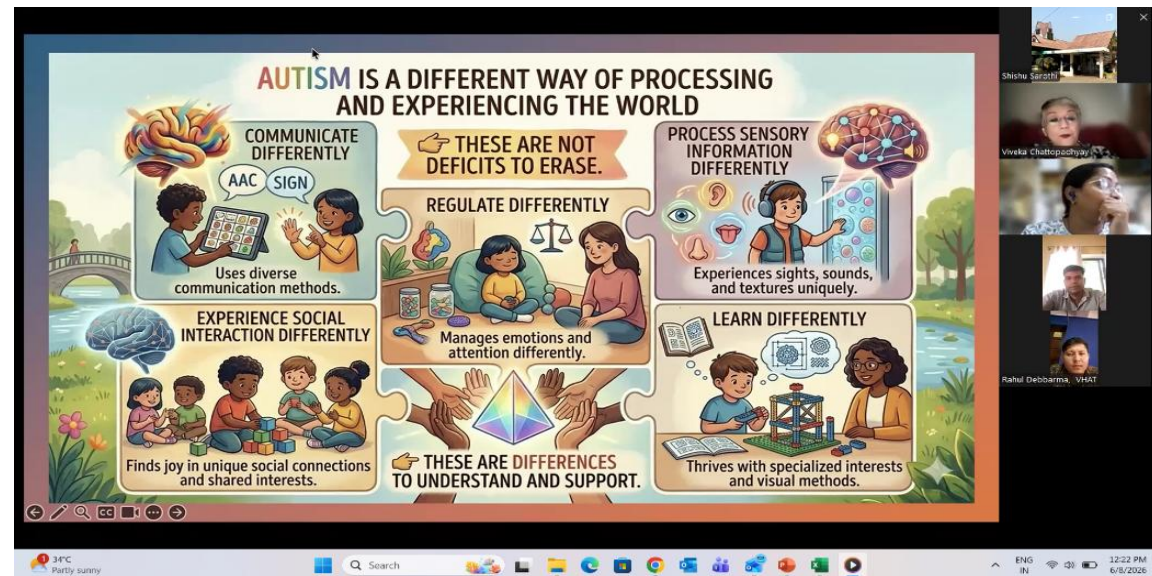
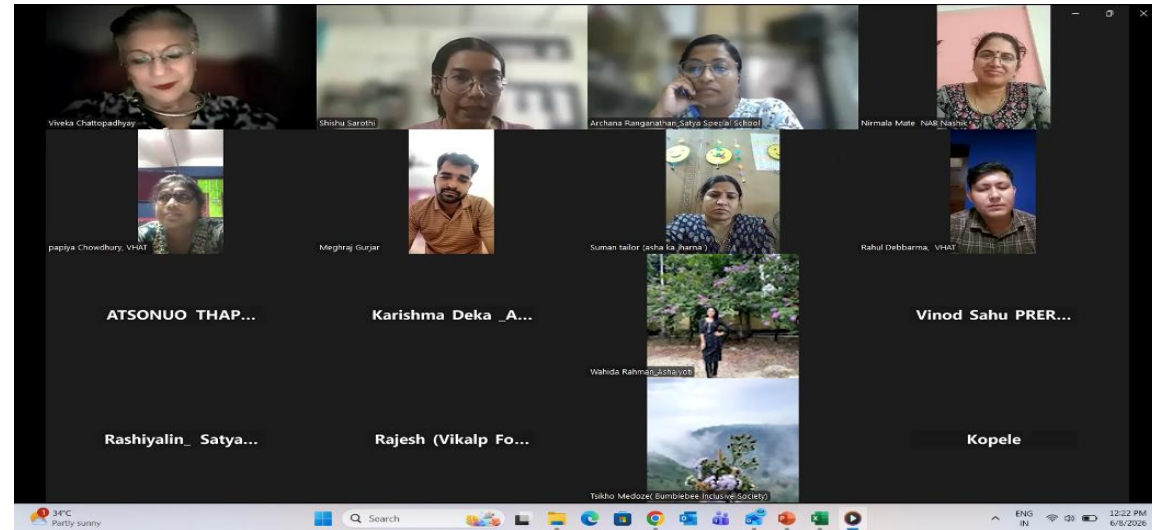
